

WCAG: 4 main principles

1. Perceivable
 - o Information and user interface components must be presentable to users in ways they can perceive.
 - o Accessible to people who are blind and/or deaf
2. Operable
 - o User interface components and navigation must be operable.
 - o Features are accessible by keyboard; not just by mouse/touch.
3. Understandable
 - o Information and the operation of user interface must be understandable.
4. Robust
 - o Content must be robust enough that it can be interpreted reliably by a wide variety of user agents, including assistive technologies.
