Staff exchanges promote the international, interdisciplinary and inter-sectoral exchange of scientific, technical and administrative staff through joint research projects in Europe and beyond.

ERASMUS+ Mobility

Find out how the Erasmus+ program supports not only students, but also university staff during stays abroad. Learn about the various funding opportunities that enable you to gain valuable professional experience at a university or educational institution abroad.

Marshall Plan Scholarship

The Marshall Plan Scholarship is aimed at students who are planning a research stay in the USA. Find out more about the requirements, funding amounts and application modalities.
