

Joanna Kulczycka, Professor of Management AGH University of Krakow, Poland

Prof. Joanna Kulczycka – Head and Founder of the Division of Strategic Research and the Department of Circular Economy at the Mineral and Energy Economy Research Institute, Polish Academy of Sciences (MEERI PAS), and Professor at the Academy of Krakow Faculty of Management, and Director of the IATI Bureau – the largest virtual research institute in Poland.

She is the author of over 250 publications, including the first book on Life Cycle Assessment (LCA) in Polish, the first *Polish Minerals Yearbook*, and more than 120 peer-reviewed scientific articles covering raw materials, the circular economy, energy and waste management, eco-efficiency of industrial processes, and corporate social responsibility (CSR).

Prof. Kulczycka has been actively involved in numerous national and European research and innovation projects, such as MinFuture, European Waste Management, Difass, Sigma for Water, BattValue, RMSmanager, Bioren, GreenOffshoreTech, Sitrans, Minteco, and ValorWaste. She served as organiser and Chair of the Steering Committee of EUIndTech2025 – Industrial Technologies and Materials for a Sustainable Europe, the EU flagship event held under the Polish Presidency of the Council of the European Union.

She is a member of the UNEP International Resource Panel (IRP) and of the Advisory Board of the Ministry of Climate and Environment of Poland. She also holds the position of President of the Waste Management and Recycling Cluster – a Key National Cluster in Poland,
